

MBCI Learning Plan and Important Dates – January 2022

January 7	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students may return to campus to retrieve necessary materials from their lockers. Teachers will notify students through Edsby by the evening of January 6 what materials are required. Please note that students are asked only to come to campus to pick up what they require for next week.• Students should use front office doors to enter and may leave at the nearest exit to their locker.• Please keep time spent on campus to a minimum. Teachers are not available for in-person questions at this time. Please contact teachers through Edsby or email with any questions.• If Friday, January 7, isn't suitable, it will still be possible to retrieve materials next week.
January 10-14	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• One week of remote learning.• Students will follow the regular cycle day schedule and daily class schedule.• All learning will take place on Teams. A video tutorial will be posted on Edsby so all students are familiar with this platform.• Learning plans for each class to be posted in Edsby and will include maximum of 40 minutes synchronous instruction per class. Teams link to be included with each learning plan.• If possible, students should download the Microsoft Teams App, or make sure they are operating in the Chrome browser.• No athletics practices or extra-curricular activities will run next week.
On Campus Option for grade 5/6 children of Critical Service Workers	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Students in grades 5 and 6, who are the children of Critical Service Workers, may learn on campus during the week of January 10 – 14.• A separate email has gone out to parents/guardians of students in grades 5 and 6.
January 17	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• All students return to campus for in-person learning.• Protocols do not require us to cohort, so students will be on campus every day.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students should continue to use designated entrances and lunch spaces. • The province does not provide the option for elective remote learning.
<p>Protocols for Restriction Level Orange</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medical-style masks are required for all students and staff. No cloth masks are permitted.
